## Wow-Factor Features

Not surprisingly, this home's interior rivals the natural beauty found outside, with such features as seven bedrooms and eight bathrooms—including the master suite with vaulted ceilings—plus a marble bathroom and an enormous dressing room with walk-in closet. The state-of-the-art kitchen has stainless steel appliances, marble countertops and a built-in breakfast nook. Spilling open from the kitchen, the family room contains a fireplace and two walls of floor-to-ceiling windows that flood the room with natural light. A separate dining room sits between the family room and living room, which contains another fireplace and expansive floor-to-ceiling windows that draw the outdoors in. Other living spaces include a home theater, a bonus room, a home gym and an office. There's also a separate apartment; four-car garage; and a courtyard with a saltwater pool, infinity hot tub and fireplace.

# NATURAL BEAUTY

Against a forested backdrop, this Buckhead estate is the epitome of a classic country manor.

Minutes from Chastain Park and Buckhead, this gated estate calls to mind the luxurious manors found along the English countryside. With such distinguishing features as solid mahogany arched doors, a three-story hammered iron staircase and even a “great lawn” for croquet, this home is a classic testament to architecture of the past while incorporating many of today's modern accents. “The design is classic yet lends itself to the more transitional style,” says Wendy Zoller-Corry of Atlanta Fine Homes Sotheby's International Realty ([wendy@wendyzoller.com](mailto:wendy@wendyzoller.com), [wendyzoller.com](http://wendyzoller.com)), who is listing the property for \$3.97 million. Details include Calcutta gold marble, limestone floors, Water Works fixtures and dark oak hardwood floors, all linked by state-of-the-art technology.

Designed by architect Keith Summerour and constructed by Benecki Homes in 2004, the house located at 5229 Riverview Road NW blends in with its surroundings through the use of white stucco and a multicolored slate roof. Cozying up to the house, fern gardens, iris-laden streams, a pond and a fire pit provide serenity that belies the property's in-town address. “The fountains and swimming pool create a spalike peaceful environment far from the hectic noise and bustle of the city,” says Zoller-Corry.

Despite loving to entertain at this house, the seller has made the tough choice to move out west to the mountains—but you can be sure whoever purchases this estate will grow to love it just as much.
